6. PROPS. A replacement pen, along with two additional backups, were acquired from Krista's office.

7. SOUND. The adjustment made to the preshow music yesterday was found to be a bit too loud when we listened to it during sound check because the beginning of the track is naturally louder than the rest. We readjusted the level back down a bit.

8. LIGHTS. The scoop lights hung from the fly rail began slowly flashing on to full and off during intermission, even though the work lights were locked out. After calling Mandy, they were unplugged for the rest of the show. No other mysterious light flashes were seen
